Piemonte

Piedmont is located in the Northwest area of Italy, hugging the Mediterranean coast. Being close to the alps, the area enjoys a high altitude, with the best vineyards benefiting from the hills and elevation. Known for its famous sub-districts, Piedmont delivers some of the most distinctive, high-quality, ageable wine of Italy. Most popular are the DOCG districts Barolo and Barbaresco, producing Nebbiolo-based wine of the same name.

Toscana

Veneto

Production includes lovely spritzy Proseccos (also the grape name), as well as the easy-drinking white wine of Soave (made from the white grape, Garganega) and the red wine of Amarone.

Puglia

Puglia excels at warm-climate wines made with indigenous grapes. The Primitivo grape (Primitivo di Manduria) is famously linked genetically to Zinfandel. Local wines show ripe berry nuances, inky concentration and soft tannins. Salice Salentino has planted Negroamaro for hearty reds.

Umbria

Umbria is a wine region tucked in central Italy, surrounded by Tuscany, Latium and the Marche. Umbria is best known for its white wines, particularly Orvieto. This wine accounts for the majority of all the wine produced from the region. Being south of Tuscany, the practice of blending Sangiovese with other international varieties is common.
